Key vocabulary

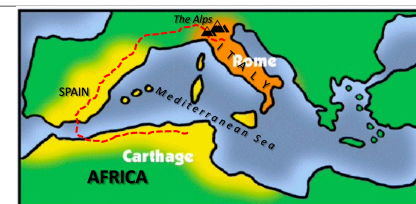
Romulus and Remus	Twin brothers, raised by a wolf, who it was believed built the city of Rome
Tarquin	Last king of Rome who was banished for cruelty
senate	Rulers of Rome who represented the people
republic	Political idea meaning Rome was governed by two senators, who were voted for by the senate, and ruled together
Carthaginians	People from a North African city called Carthage that fought in 3 wars with Rome
Hannibal	African military commander and son of Hamilcar (leader of Carthage) who led the Carthaginians in the 3rd Punic War
Patricians	Most important Romans who could trace their ancestry back to the 100 founding fathers of Rome
enslaved	Captured prisoners of war who were not Roman citizens

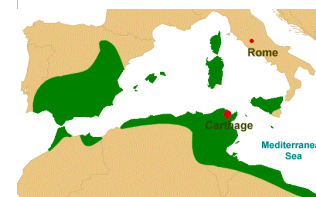
Roman Empire 246 BC

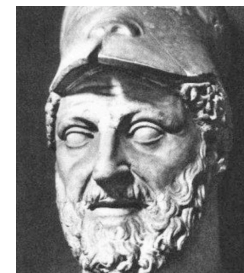

264 BC First Punic War begins against Carthage

44 BC Julius Caesar assassinated

410 AD Roman occupation of Britain ends

1453 AD Byzantine Empire (Eastern half of the Roman Empire) falls
