Creating Music

Key vocabulary

Music	the pattern of sounds produced by people singing or playing instruments
Emotions	Feelings such as happiness, <u>love</u> , fear, <u>anger</u> , or <u>hatred</u>
Pulse	In music, a <mark>pulse</mark> is a regular beat, which is often produced by a <u>drum</u> .
Rhythm	A regular series of sounds or movements
Pattern	the repeated or regular way in which something happens or is done.
Pitch	The pitch of a sound is how high or low it is.
Tempo	The tempo of a piece of music is the speed at which it is played.
Instrument	A musical instrument is an object such as a <u>piano</u> , <u>guitar</u> , or <u>flute</u> , which you play in order to produce music.
Sound	Sound is energy that travels in waves through air, water, or other substances, and can be heard.
Note	In music, a note is the sound of a particular pitch, or a written symbol representing this sound.

By clicking on the different squares, you can make different musical notes. The higher up you click, the higher the pitch!	
Clicking on the shapes below the notes allows you to add in percussion, e.g. drums and symbols.	
You can change the instruments that make the sounds, by clicking on the different options in the bottom left.	Piano Electronic
By moving the dot along this bar (at the bottom of the page) you can change the tempo, making it faster or slower.	Tempo 120
