

Year 2 Striking and Fielding

Key vocabulary					
Striking	Players score points by hitting (striking) an object and running to designated playing areas.				
Fielding	Prevent opponents from scoring by retrieving the object and returning it to stop the play.				
Batting	Hitting an object with a cricket bat or rounders bat				
Cricket	A bat and ball game, where one team fields and the other bats, players score runs by running between the wickets.				
Rounders	A bat and ball game, where one team fields and the other bats, players must run round 4 bases to score a run.				
Throw	To aim a ball to a particular target or place.				
Catch	Moving into the line of the ball or under a ball in the air to prevent it from touching the ground.				
Overarm	The ball is passed through the air when the hand and arm are above the shoulder.				
Underarm	Underarm The ball is passed through the air when the hand and arm are under the shoulder.


