Bank	A place for keeping or borrowing money.
Shop	A small store.
Job	A task or piece of work for which a person is paid to do.
Work	A task or project that uses such effort.
Purse	A pouch or bag used for carrying money.
Wages	Money paid to a person for doing work or giving help.
Savings	Money that has been collected over a period of time.
Receipt	A piece of paper showing that money or things were received.
Money	The coins or paper notes used to buy things or pay for services.
Spend	To pay out.
Income	The money received for work.
Lost	To no longer have or be unable to find.
Stolen	To take from another without permission.

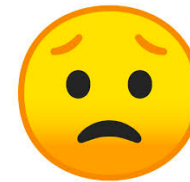
Ways we get money

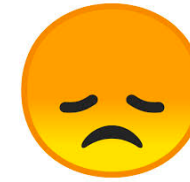
